Dream art = **refutation of** the **exclusivity** of the actual world. Appreciation motivates expr. of one's inside, b/c artists and viewers alike find sanity in behaving insanely (w/n the confines of art). While dream art allows to transform oneself outside social reality, manifesting visions is important for democracy b/c expressing imagination = a reminder of the individuality of a person's internal life.

revelation: painters project their own vision phobia lurking in our psyche

Rendering and appreciating Art is a magically **connective experience**. The more personal a work of art, the more it can help to undestand personality as such. Visual art empowers imagination of artist +viewer. Visualize the **unseen forces** both secular and spiritual, the universe + the recesses of the unconscious mind: ephemeral feelings, unknowable mysteries, personal fantasies + inner visions
